**PLEASE NOTE:** If the Governor calls a special election to fill a vacancy in the State Legislature, deadlines shown below will be superseded by the deadlines for a special legislative election for all counties and all entities included in the legislative district where the vacancy exists.

\* The 20<sup>th</sup> day following the resolution due date is the **last possible day** on which to begin a special candidate filing period. Entities should set dates for a special filing period as soon as possible after a resolution is adopted.
